GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

* A Participant can only participate in the Event if he has completed an appropriate registration fully and truthfully, if the entry fee has been paid in full and if the Participant has agreed to the General Terms & Conditions

The Participant will receive a Bib number from the Organiser which will show his allocated participation number. The Participant must attach the Bib number to his chest. The Bib number must be attached and worn in such a way that the participation number and other information are easy to see. The Bib number cannot be trimmed or folded. The Participant is prohibited from wearing other Bib numbers than the one he has received from the Organiser. Failure to comply may result in disqualification. If the participant is unable to participate in the event, the entry fee will be refunded after one week of the event with prior notice of 7 days.

* For reasons of major or exceptional circumstances the organizer can decide to cancel the event at short notice.

* Participation is at the participant's own risk. The organizer is not liable for any damages, unless the damage is due to the negligence on the part of the organizer.

*A winner is eligible for cash prize only if there are minimum 15 participants in each category. The winner will get the cash prize only after the organizers carry out the verification check of the winners and then the cash prize cheque will be couriered or amount transferred to winner's account.

*The Participant grants the Organizer the right to publish pictures and image material etc., recorded during or around the time of the Event, in which the participant is visible. In the context of the Event, by or on behalf of the Organizer made photographs, films or other materials or (electronic) files are the property of the organizer. Unless the Participant has notified the Organizer in writing well in advance differently, the Participant grants permission to the Organizer to publish during and around the Event captured images, videos or other materials with the participant this can either be done for communication or commercial purposes and solely by the Organizer and/or his sponsors.

*The Organiser will save personal data provided by the Participant in a database. By participating in an Event, a Participant grants the Organiser permission to use the personal data to send information to the Participant and (provided the Participant has given permission for this on the registration form) to provide personal data to third parties for the purpose of sending information to the Participant. By entering into the Agreement, the Participant grants the Organiser permission to publish his name and competition results, for instance by means of publication in newspapers and via the Internet.

*The Organiser will determine the result and is entitled to change the result if any inaccuracies have been noted. A Participant must return any prizes to the Organiser if a change to the result means that the Participant is no longer entitled to the prize.
